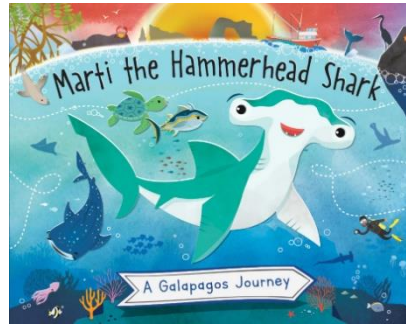




A guide to guided reading with Marti



This guided reading resource has been adapted from materials designed to go with this [book](#) from the Galapagos Conservation Trust, for you to use at home with your child.

Please read the following points and suggestions to help you gain the most from the book and sessions with your child.



The book is designed for readers aged between 7-11 years with some guidance where necessary.



There are 6 sessions with resource materials provided.



The book has been converted into a PowerPoint presentation.

There is also a separate presentation of the book being read.

As is the case when we complete guided reading, it is suggested you don't read any further unless directed, as following sessions rely on an element of 'surprise.'



Each session is provided with session notes for you to follow. These highlight the session focus, key vocabulary and also new species found on each page.

It is split into a pre-read/warm up, guided/independent read and post-read/review, with a few fun extras!

Check through notes before the session as some ask you to write key prompt questions to use during reading.



There is no time constraint for you to complete sessions. In the classroom the session last between 45mins-1 hour. You may prefer to split sessions at home.
